

Maintenance of roof safety products

According to the Planning and Building Act (PBL) and the Act on Technical Requirements for Construction Works, inspections of roof safety devices must be carried out regularly. Weland Stål recommends that this is done annually. Rooftop safety equipment is essential for working safely at height. But having the equipment in place is not enough – regular maintenance is essential to ensure it functions as intended and provides the protection required.

Inspection points:

- The safety devices have been installed in accordance with Weland Stål's installation instructions.
- When completing individual roof safety assemblies, parts from different manufacturers must not be mixed within the same product group.
- Deformed and/or damaged safety devices/fastenings must be replaced.
- Any paintwork damage on the products must be touched up to prevent corrosion. This does not apply to hot dipped galvanized or stainless steel products.
- Also check whether roof safety needs to be supplemented so roof work can be carried out in a healthy and safe environment (Swedish Work Environment Act, Chapter 2 § 2), even in the future.
- Where there is a risk of excess accumulation, snow guards must be cleared of snow.
